

THE TRUTH ABOUT RATS



RATS CARRY DISEASES.

Rats are known to transmit salmonella, hantavirus, rat bite fever, and plague, among other diseases.

RATS LOVE CHEESE.

While they probably won't refuse cheese, rats generally prefer grains, fruits, vegetables, & seeds.

RATS DON'T HAVE BONES.

Despite their ability to squeeze into openings the size of a quarter, rats do in fact have a skeletal system.

RATS CAN GET INSIDE VIA PIPES/DRAINS.

Rats have no problem finding their way to the surface by traveling through plumbing, even (rarely) exiting through toilets.

RATS BREED LIKE CRAZY.

A female rat typically births 6 litters per year, of between 5-10 pups per litter - and they are able to breed at just 3 to 4 months old!

CATS HELP TO CONTROL RATS.

A cat is NOT an effective method of rat control. Rats breed too quickly and can squeeze into small spaces - and many cats are simply too lazy to care!

DIY RAT CONTROL IS SAFE & EFFECTIVE.

Because of the risk of disease, the damage they can cause, and rapid reproduction rates, it's best to leave rat control to the professionals - and rodent control experts can determine the best way to keep them out for good.
